Case Consultation Training Series Request for Applications
Questions and Answers
November 30, 2018**

How can I sign my therapists up to attend?

For therapists to be considered for this training, your agency must respond to the Request for Applications (RFA) posted on the CBH website. The application must be submitted no later than 2:00 pm on December 10, 2018.

What are the dates and times of the training series?

The dates and times are to be determined once the agencies are selected. The facilitators intend to work with selected agencies to determine a schedule and location(s) accessible by all participants.

I would like to send my 3 clinicians to the training, but I am wondering if all 3 have to go to every training. Would I be able to alternate them?

Each clinician will attend all the scheduled monthly trainings for their respective group for the entire 3 hours, so that groups of clinicians remain intact throughout the training period. Maintaining consistent membership throughout the training/consultation program fosters a group process that encourages openness and risk taking on the part of the members.

Multiple group options and times will be offered, and clinicians from the same agency may be in different groups.

I am wondering how many continuing education credits (CEUs) will be offered as part of this series?

Therapists and supervisors who attend all sessions are eligible to receive up to 30 CEUs.

Does the training series consistently meet in person?

Yes, all sessions are held in-person, and all attendees will participate in-person.

Will there be any groups for Spanish speaking providers?

Yes, there will be one group facilitated in Spanish for Spanish-speaking clinicians.
