Acute Inpatient Psychiatric Hospitalization for Pregnant Women

CBH recognizes that there are treatment challenges associated with acute inpatient psychiatric hospitalization for pregnant women. To support providers caring for pregnant women, CBH will be offering a standard per diem rate of \$1,200 for providers who admit a pregnant woman onto their acute psychiatric inpatient unit. CBH expects that the acute inpatient hospital will provide comprehensive and integrated services to include collaboration with obstetric and pediatric providers, as well as other supports, including family and/or partner to ensure optimal care is being delivered. CBH remains committed to facilitating positive outcomes for a pregnant woman experiencing a psychiatric crisis and her potential offspring.

CBH will include a new level of care on the inpatient psychiatric hospital provider's contract:

• 100-39 Inpatient Psychiatric Acute Hospital Services Pregnant Woman

CBH Clinical Care Management will generate the authorization under the new level of care. The provider will need to submit the claim with an ICD-10 pregnancy diagnostic code in order for the claim to be paid.
