

## Community Behavioral Health: Provider Notice Reporting of Coronavirus March 12, 2020 (Revised April 15, 2020) (Revised December 1, 2020)

At this time, in order to monitor the developing COVID-19 pandemic and its potential effects at Community Behavioral Health (CBH)-contracted provider sites, **CBH** is requiring providers to submit reports for laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19, suspected positive cases of COVID-19, and COVID-19 deaths; providers must report confirmed COVID-19 cases, suspected cases, and deaths among *both* staff and members.

CBH had previously accepted this information on the Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS) COVID-19 Reporting Form. Due to changes in OMHSAS reporting protocols, this is no longer possible. **Starting December 1, 2020, this information should be submitted to CBH as advised in CBH Bulletin 20-20: Significant Incident Reporting.** 

Providers should refer to the <u>Philadelphia Department of Public Health (PDPH) coronavirus</u> <u>webpage</u> for additional information and reporting requirements related to COVID-19.

CBH will require confirmation that the provider has contacted PDPH Division of Disease Control at 215-685-6740 and is following their recommendations.
