## Agenda

### I. Review of Agenda

Dr. Faith Dyson Washington drew the attention of the members to the provided agenda.

### II. Welcome & Introductions

Members of council introduced themselves and stated their agency/organization/role and area of expertise.

### III. IBHS Background and Goals

Dr. Tamra Williams described when OMHSAS first established new regulations for Intensive Behavioral Health Services (IBHS) to replace Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services (BHRS) and School Therapeutic Services (STS). IBHS regulations were promulgated in October 2019. IBHS is both a licensing change at the state level as well as programmatic change.

Dr. Williams provided an overview of the IBHS services available in both school and community settings and described the benefits of the regionalized approach.

The goals of IBHS were outlined, as well as the projected general outcomes for students, teachers, school leadership, and school support staff.

### IV. Current Landscape

Donna Bailey provided an update on the current landscape of IBHS including the relationships between providers and schools, how providers have responded during the Covid-19 pandemic, and how CBH has been utilizing a Alternative Payment Arrangement (APA) to support providers during the pandemic.

**V. IBHS Coordinating Council (these slides were discussed later in the meeting)**

The purpose of the IBHS Coordinating Council was described. Dr. Tamra Williams was identified as Chair of the Coordinating Council, and Julia Hinckley was identified as co-chair. The role of the Coordinating Council members was also discussed.

**VI. DC Coordinating Council**

Dr. Olga Acosta Price provided an overview of how the DC Coordinating Council was established and implemented, and her work in supporting a comprehensive school behavioral health system in DC.

**VII. Next Steps**

These include adding a student peer to participate on the council and finalizing the IBHS Coordinating Council charter, which will be sent out to Council members for review and editing.
