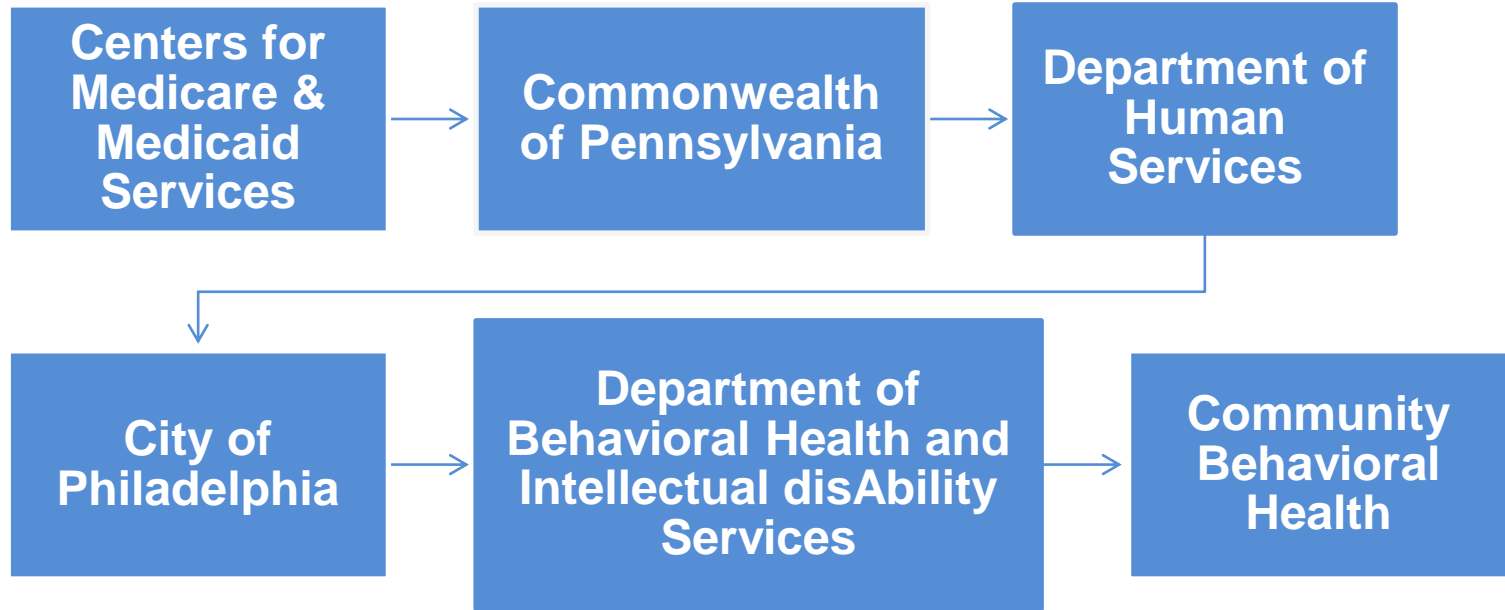
City of Philadelphia

- Single payer system operated by the City

 - Substance Use and Mental Health
 - Range of services from hospitals to outpatient programs

 - Consensus review panel will score each application
 - Highest scoring applicants will be awarded
 - 5 awardees- 5 participants from each awarded provider

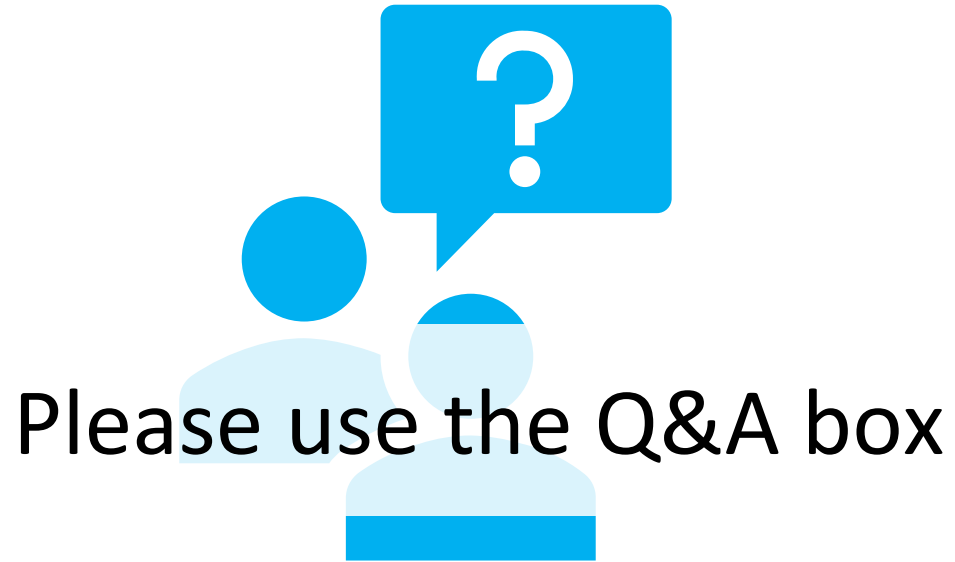

Requests for the relocation of existing services may still be submitted for consideration.

Please note that the CBH website will be the only guaranteed method of notice for CBH-related RFPs and RFQs. RFPs and RFQs are issued under strict requirements and any responses to an RFP that does not meet the specified requirements, including not submitting responses within the timelines stated in the RFP, will be cause for disqualification.
