Agenda

1. Review of Agenda

Dr. Faith Dyson Washington reviewed the agenda.

2. Welcome & Introductions

Members of the council were asked to put their name and agency in the zoom chat box.

3. Updates to the Charter

Julia Hinckely discussed recent updates/changes to the IBHS Coordinating Council Charter, which Council members suggested. These updates related to:

- » Voting - moving forward, if a formal vote is needed, each Committee member will get one vote.
- » Provider terms – these were added, and providers were given “seat” numbers. Seats were assigned alphabetically by agency name.

No feedback or suggested changes, so this charter will be finalized.

4. EBP Training Timeline

Dr. Williams updated the group on a recent meeting held on Friday, 5/14/21, to discuss the EBP implementation plan for provider training. Feedback from that meeting will be used in the final decisions about the order in which providers will be trained. Top issues raised related to expectation for providers previously trained in an EBP; feeder zip codes and relation to high violence neighborhoods; and concerns over community school representation. The final plan will be shared during our next CC meeting on 6/17/21. For our next meeting, we will be reviewing the outcome goals for IBHS. As a reminder, these are the goals that were highlighted in our RFP.

This overview included a discussion of the history of school-based services and the strengths and challenges of the IBHS model.

Questions:

Question: Are we any closer to figuring out how to select a youth member to join the council?

Answer: We received a recommendation for someone who serves on another youth/peer group. We want to make sure we have a good sense of how to utilize this member before moving forward.

Question: Should EBP training include a component of cultural competency? Some students have mentioned concerns around cultural insensitivity when engaging with services.

Answer: Strategies for providing culturally and linguistically appropriate treatment will be interwoven into the training for the 3 EBPs associated with IBHS.
