EPIC EBP Program Designation Application Platform Change

The Evidence-based Practice and Innovation Center (EPIC) will be launching a new application system for the EPIC Evidence Based Practices (EBP) Program Designation Application. Effective June 30, 2021, the EPIC EBP Program Designation will no longer be available through Form.com, the current platform. The designation application will be transferred to a QuickBase application and will be available to access on July 1, 2021.

To ensure that all data from Form.com is transferred to QuickBase, application submissions will be frozen as of June 15, 2021. Any applications submitted after June 15, 2021, will still be reviewed but the information will not be transferred to QuickBase, meaning that applications will need to be reentered in QuickBase by the applying agency. Partially completed applications in Form.com will not be transferred to QuickBase.

Providers with completed designation applications will receive login information from EPIC. Historical data will be transferred from Form.com to QuickBase with a minimal need for providers to re-submit information.
