## Agenda

### I. Welcome & Introductions

### II. Review of Agenda and Reminders

Dr. Faith Dyson Washington reviewed the agenda and reminded council members to send agenda items to Stacey Golonka by the first of each month.

### III. Demographics Discussion

During last month’s meeting, there was a request for the IBHS Demographics data to be rereviewed. Dr. Williams reviewed the Demographics data and shared additional preliminary data related to which IBHS levels of care are being the most utilized. The

Committee engaged in a discussion about the trends and disparities that are being shown in the data and the implications for the 2021-2022 School Year; especially the opportunity to maximally utilize the Multi-tier System of Support (MTSS) process for referring youth to behavioral health supports. In reviewing trends related to diagnoses, the Committee members also discussed the importance of clinicians being trained to accurately diagnose and be educated around cultural norms when it comes to youth behaviors.

#### **IV. Youth Representatives**

Dr. Williams shared that CBH identified a youth representative, Deborah (Dee Dee) Irby. Dr. Williams lead a conversation with Committee members about how to use Youth representatives. It was recommended that the Coordinating Council include more than one peer representative and that Ms. Irby serve as liaison between the peer group and the Council. Committee Members were asked to send recommendations for additional youth representatives to Stacey Golonka.
