I. Welcome & Introductions

III. Follow-up Items

IBHS Brochure- Victoria Hepp, Project Manager from the Office of the Deputy Managing Director for Health & Human Services, provided an update on the IBHS Brochure that was shared during the September meeting. Victoria Hepp explained that the brochure is being taken to the CBH family member group at the end of the month for feedback. If ready, the final version of the brochure will be shared during the November meeting.

School vacancies- Provider members were asked to discuss vacancies they are seeing in their agency and across the provider network. Provider members shared that during all CBH Provider meetings, they report out on how many cases can't be covered. Committee members discussed that it might be helpful to have a more general discussion about any trend's providers are seeing in terms of hiring.

IBHS Data- Dr. Williams shared Quarter 1 data for completed written orders, assessment and treatment initiation. This reflected preliminary baseline data. Dr. Williams described the limits to the data. Committee discussed reasons for what may have impacted the data and what would be helpful to look at moving forward.
