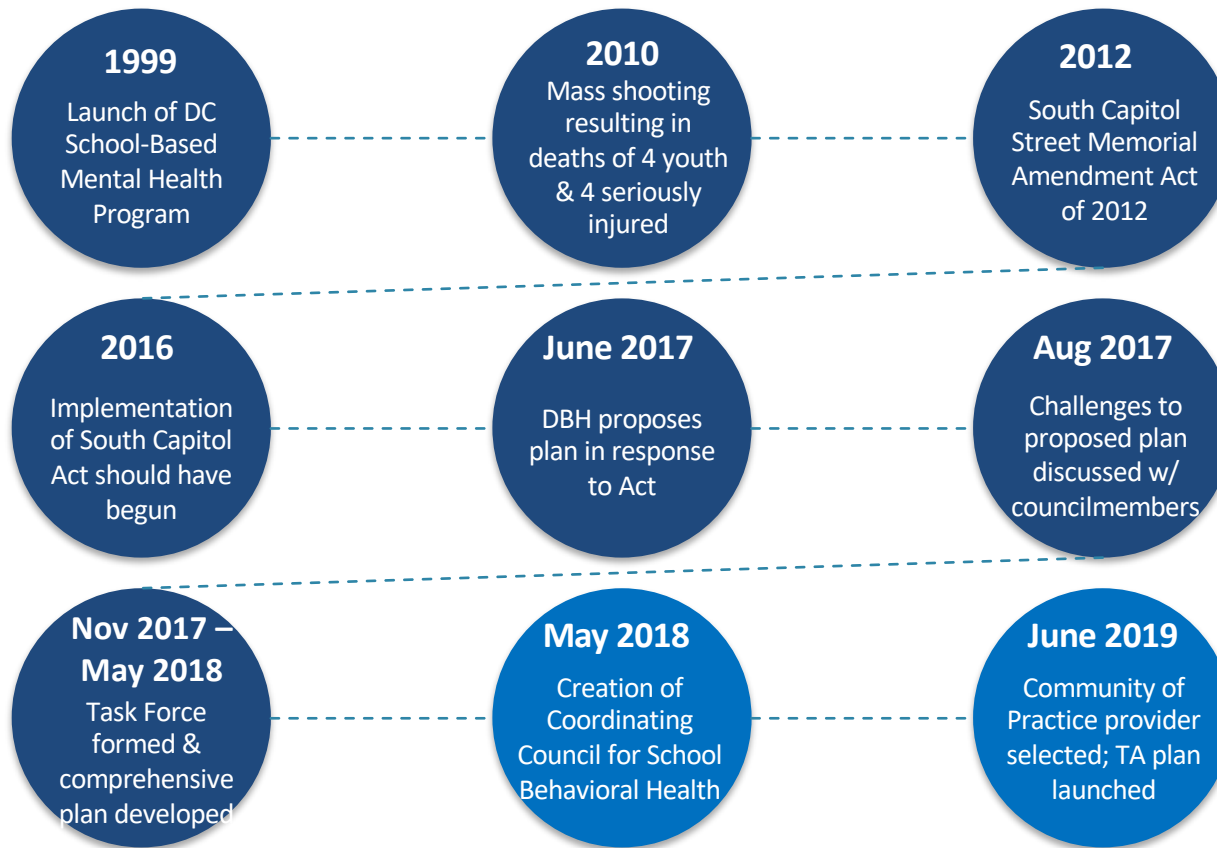

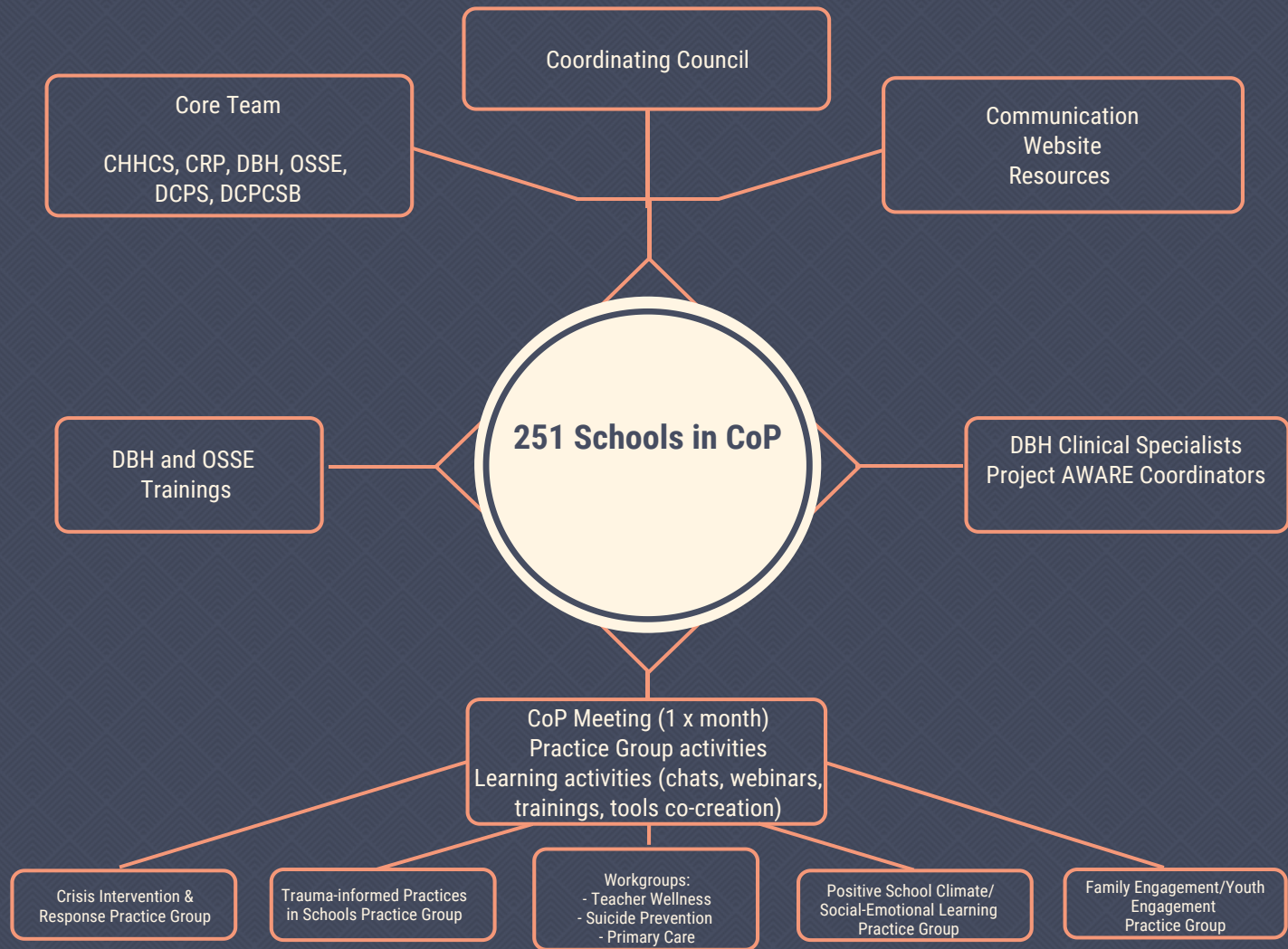

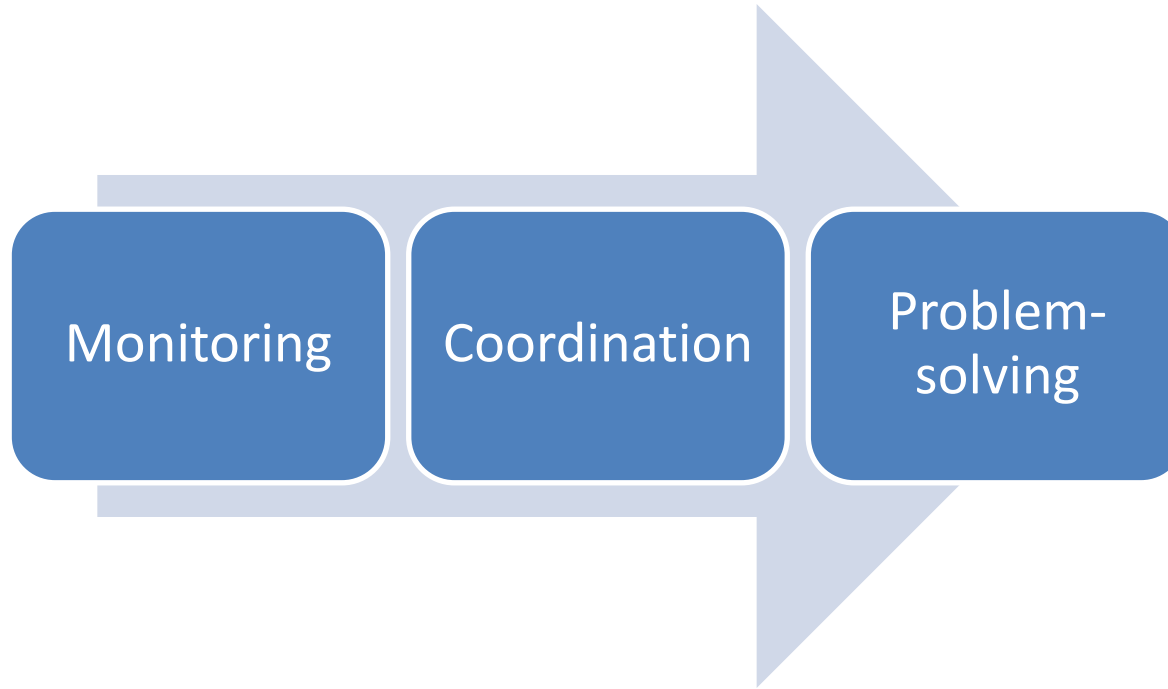
Role & Functions of the DC Coordinating Council

- Guide implementation of all elements of the Comprehensive Plan
- Assist in identifying metrics for provider readiness and capacity-building
- Provide input regarding development of an on-going learning collaborative for providers ("Community of Practice").
- Identify resource gaps and provide input to guide resource development and/or more effective utilization of needed resources.
- Help support linkages and coordination between the School-Based Behavioral Health System and other systems, agencies, initiatives, policies
- Help coordinate broader health and education activities (i.e., Medicaid reform).
- Explore workforce development strategies
- Guide development of evaluation framework, plan, and implementation.
