

Update to American Society of Addition Medicine (ASAM) Value Based Payment (VBP) Case Rate Arrangement

This Notice is to alert Providers of the claim adjudication process for American Society of Addition Medicine (ASAM) Value Based Payment (VBP).

- Providers are required to continue submitting encounters. As part of ASAM VBP, encounters will begin to pay at a \$0 rate starting April 1, 2022.
- Once the monthly encounter minimum of three services is reached, the CBH billing system will issue the case rate automatically. *Medication Management (350-5) level of care can only count for up to two of the three encounters required.
- The month is identified as the calendar month. For example: January case rate will be based on January service date, **NOT** services submitted in January.
- The claims submitted need to adjudicate for payment to count towards the encounter requirement. Rejected or denied claims will not be part of this count.
- The case rate will be present on the Claims Remittance Report (835) with the case rates billing information and the service date of the claim that triggered the case cate.
- Providers are not to submit a claim for the case rate, only encounters need to be submitted.
- Providers must continue to submit encounters even after meeting the monthly minimum.
- All encounters will adjudicate for one unit. The expectation is for Providers to bill the claims with the unit amounts that match the service provided. CBH will reprocess the claim at a later time to reflect the billed unit amounts. This process will not affect claim adjudication or the case rate payments.
