Agenda

I. Welcome & Introductions

Members of the council were asked to put their name and agency in the zoom chat box.

II. Review of Agenda and Reminders

Dr. Tamra Williams reviewed the agenda.

IV. IBHS Infographic

- V. The final draft of the IBHS Infographic was shared with Coordinating Council members. Members participated in a discussion on how to disseminate the infographic and targeted organizations for the infographic to be shared with.

VI. IBHS Survey

Committee members continued to discuss the IBHS survey and reviewed feedback from Councilperson Helen Gym's office. Dr. Williams shared that CBH plans to partner with an Academic institution to help reshape the survey questions, and Committee members agreed that this would be ideal.

The School District of Philadelphia (SDP) will be responsible for surveying principals and teachers, which will take place in the fall. Committee members discussed the possibility of surveying SDP Counselors prior to the end of the academic year, if possible.

Committee members discussed the provider survey, including which IBHS staff would complete the survey and how. It was suggested that the decisions be left up to leadership in each agency with this group providing recommendations around who should receive the survey.

For the youth survey, Committee members discussed the survey questions and whether focus groups would yield better data. Focus groups would have to take place when school resumes in the fall for younger kids (currently the survey is directed for youth 14+). It was mentioned that focus groups are often a better way to receive feedback from youth. There was discussion around whether it's appropriate for IBHS providers to disseminate the survey to the youth or if that would cause bias.

There are still outstanding decision points about the survey which will come back to the Committee once the questions are reworked.
