

Planned Changes for Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services

Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services (PRS) are anticipated to become an in-plan benefit in early 2026. This change will have no impact on the service provision for PRS.

With this anticipated change, transportation funding for PRS and Community Integrated Recovery Centers (CIRC) will shift to the Medical Assistance Transportation Program (MATP), as Medicaid funding will be designated for transportation to PRS and CIRC programs.

PRS and CIRC providers have been connected to MATP and ModivCare and should move forward with the registration and scheduling process. The ModivCare team will continue to work diligently to support this transition and provide orientation to their system and processes, while building understanding and establishing channels of communication to ensure this transition is as successful as possible.

While awaiting confirmation from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OMHSAS) for PRS to shift in plan, the expectation is that CBH members receiving CIRC support and PRS will start progressively moving to transportation that is coordinated and covered by ModivCare by February 1, 2026. Ongoing updates will be shared.
