

Revalidation of Enrollment

Provider revalidation of enrollment is a federal Medicaid requirement. Providers must revalidate their Medicaid enrollment every five years. Failure to revalidate will result in termination of a provider's Medicaid enrollment and CBH's ability to reimburse a provider for services rendered. We encourage providers to ensure they are aware of their revalidation dates and submit applications with as much lead time as possible to avoid disruption of reimbursement.

The [Office of Medical Assistance Programs \(OMAP\)](#) has announced an anticipated increase in provider revaluation applications later this year and into next year. Providers are encouraged to review their revalidation due dates and submit applications as early as possible to avoid processing delays; applications can be submitted up to 90 days before their due date through the DHS [PROMISE Provider Portal](#).
