- ➔ Obtaining staff buy-in for EBP training through clear communication of expectations and incentivizing participation via additional compensation, rewards, or recognition
- ➔ Maintaining awareness of staff's participation in and completion of required training and consultation
- ➔ Allocating necessary resources and providing oversight to ensure successful implementation and service delivery
- ➔ Engaging in regular and consistent data submission (where applicable) to maintain eligibility in accessing future EBP trainings
- ➔ Applying for EBP Program Designation through EPIC and maintaining designated status via annual renewal
