

1. Section 2.3.1. Required Personnel states the director of psychiatric nursing services must be a registered nurse with a master's degree (or its equivalent). What is the equivalent?

Equivalent experience for the director of psychiatric nursing services may be a registered nurse who meets the minimum requirements as outlined in the Pennsylvania State Code: <u>55 Pa. Code § 1101</u> and <u>55 Pa. Code § 1151</u>.

2. Section 2.2.5. Medical Services states that the BHDD AIP should have physician capacity. Can a nurse practitioner be used in this role instead of a physician?

A psychiatrist is required as part of the staffing on the BHDD AIP unit. For individuals who may require more intensive medical services, an initial evaluation may be completed by a physician or nurse practitioner and then may be referred to the appropriate medical services. If a provider is not affiliated with a medical hospital, they may have an MOU with a medical hospital to ensure whole-person integrated care is provided.

3. Will the communication assessments be conducted prior to the client arriving to the program, or will the communication assessment be conducted once the clients arrive?

The communication assessment should be conducted by the BHDD AIP as indicated in Section 2.2.4 Other Assessments. Proposals should include what communication assessment will be utilized, a plan for training staff in the assessment and how the recommended interventions and strategies will be incorporated into individualized treatment plans.

4. Can startup costs be used for renovations?

Yes, renovations may be included as part of the available startup costs. Providers should submit budgets including how they will use the startup costs as part of their proposal.
