

Changes to the Staff Licensure Requirement for Adult Mobile Crisis Supervisors

Effective April 21, 2023, the requirement for Adult Mobile Crisis Supervisors will be changed to allow for unlicensed individuals work in the position while pursuing licensure. It is expected that this will assist in recruiting and provide career development opportunities. Under the new requirements, the provider will be responsible ensuring that the supervision requirement has been completed and the licensure occurs within one year of hire.

The new requirements for an Adult Mobile Crisis Supervisor are as follows:

- Completed master's level education with a curriculum that prepares the individual for licensure as an LCSW, LSW, LPC or LMFT.
- Any license related supervision at the time of hire must be completed with the provider.
- Licensure must occur within one year of hire.
